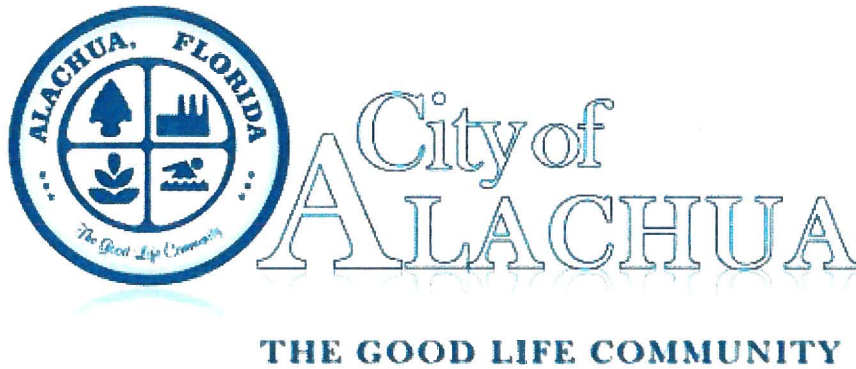

E.A. Grosz asked where on the agenda was the previous discussion listed.

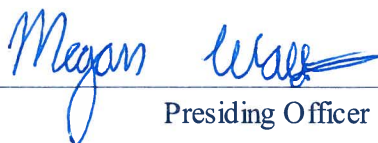
Assistant Deputy City Clerk Williams stated it was general discussion from the members, and Mr. Grosz was speaking in the Citizen Comment time.
