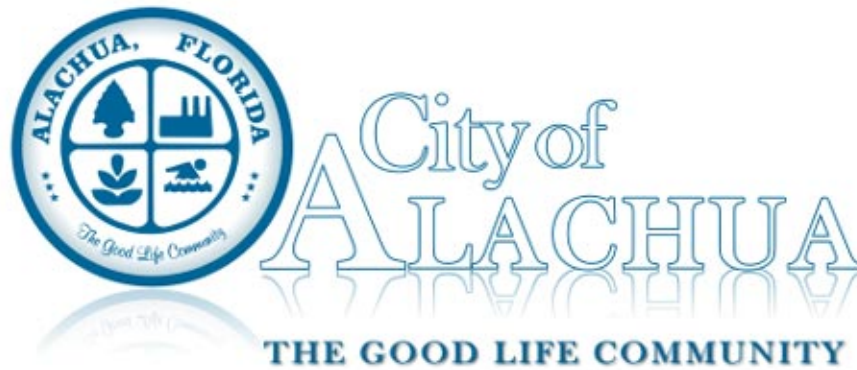

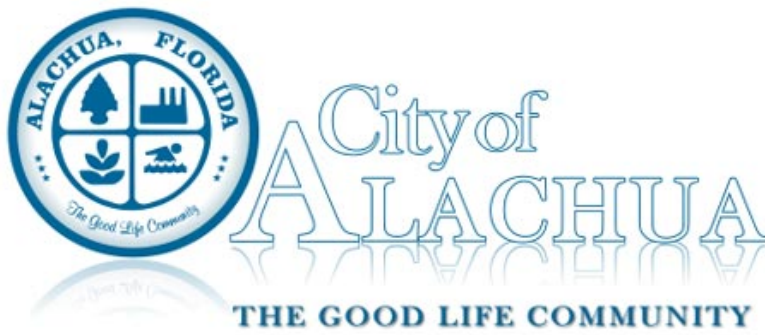

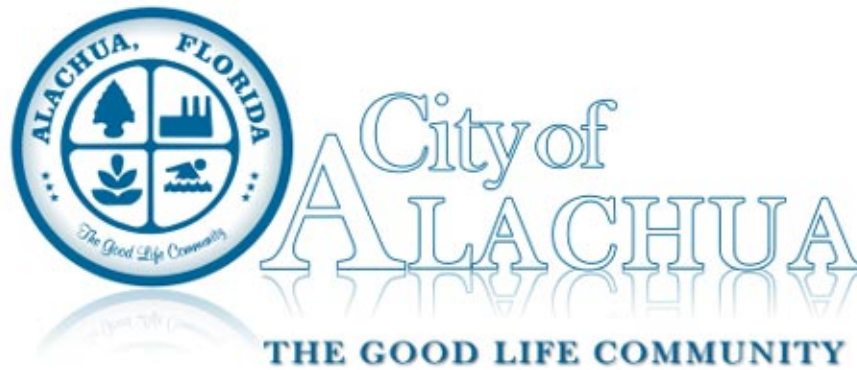

Member Latham moved to adjourn; seconded by Vice Chair Ceden-Alonso.

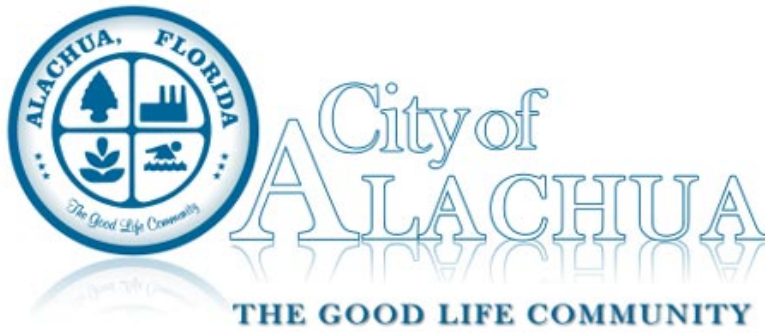

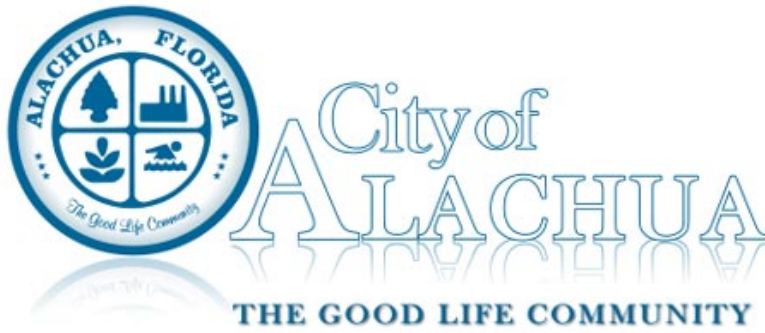

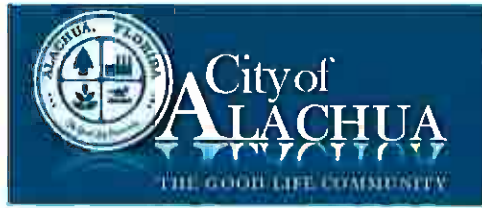
