Summary

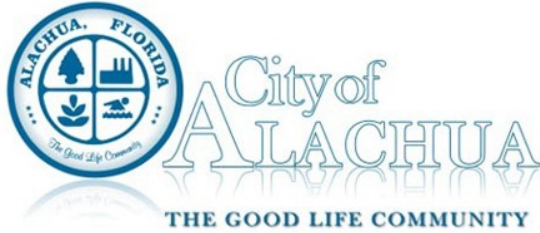

Summary

The Hathcock Community Center will serve as an important recreational and community gathering facility for residents of the City of Alachua. The City is currently advancing efforts related to the design of the future facility to ensure it meets the recreational, social, and community needs of residents. As part of this effort, there may be opportunities to incorporate thematic elements and exhibits within the facility that highlight the community's history, culture, and shared experiences.

The City is seeking input from the Senior Resources Advisory Board regarding potential themes and exhibit concepts that could be included in the Hathcock Community Center. The Board is asked to discuss possible themes and types of exhibits that could be featured in the facility. Examples may include, but are not limited to:

- Interactive or educational exhibits related to health, wellness, and lifelong learning

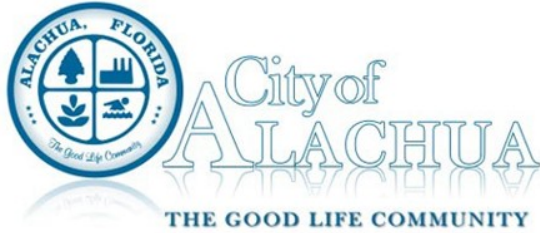

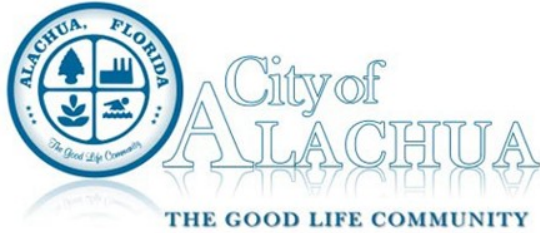
Brandon Wilson of Crafty Gemini will update the board on current and future senior activities. Mr. Wilson will also provide an update on the status of future field trips.
