Vice Chair Sloan opened the floor for comments.

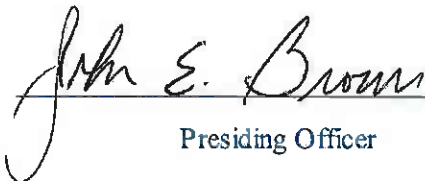
