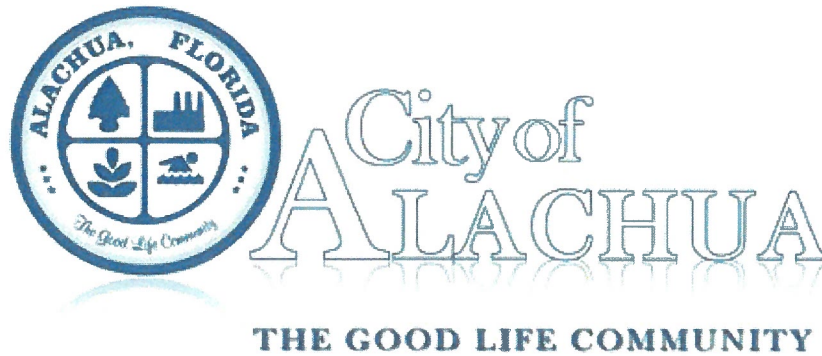

Deputy City Clerk Williams discussed the article about the Youth Advisory Council in the QC magazine and showed the board members the magazine and the pictures.

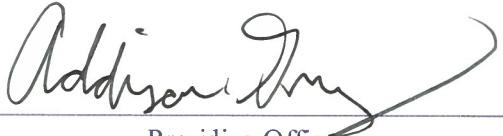

Kamal Latham congratulated the new members.

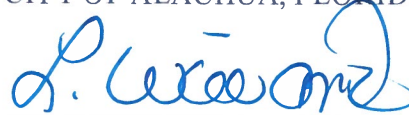
