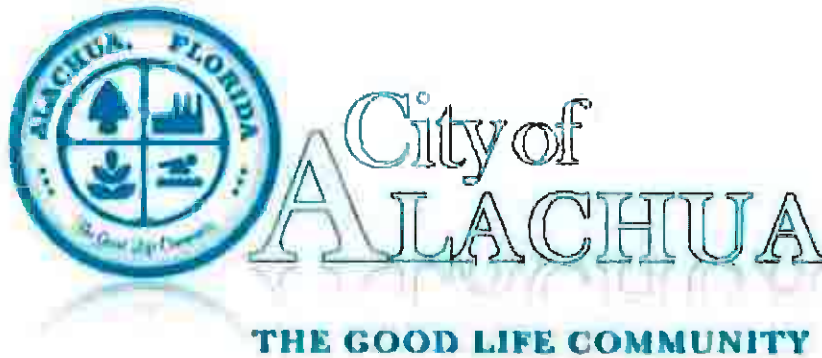

Member Latham moved to adjourn; seconded by Vice Chair Cedeno-Alonso.

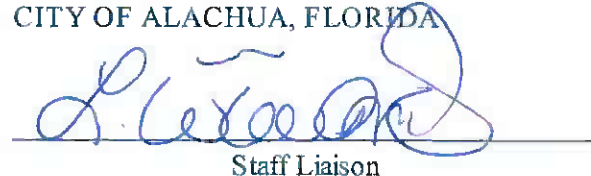
