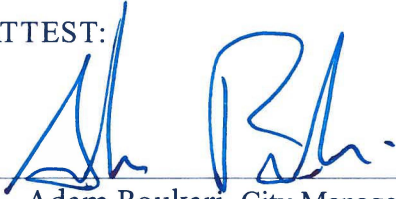
Commissioner Wilford asked if a city seal for the dais could be put in the budget.
