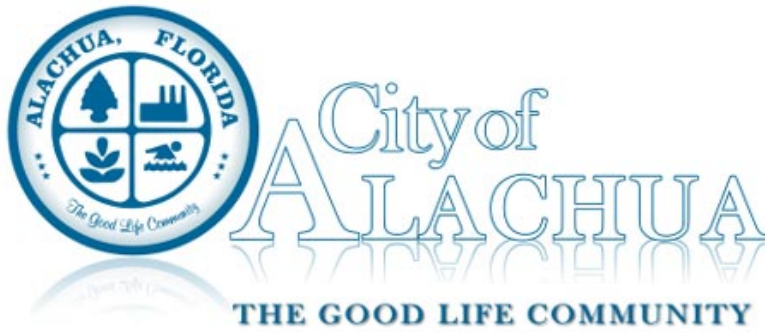

On April 6, 2023 all of the Senior Resource Advisory Board Members were in attendance for the Vision and Goals Workshop.

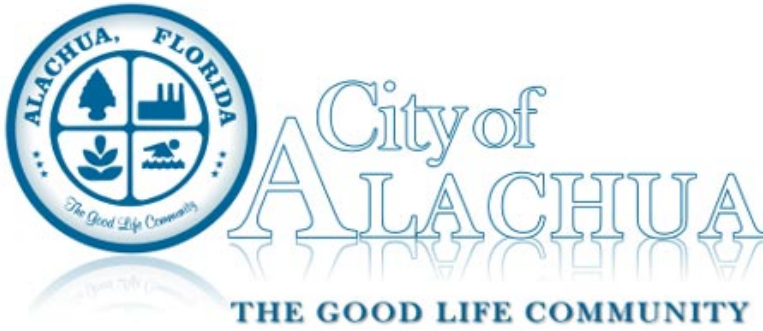
Upon conclusion, it was discussed that the SRAB would vote on the new Vision and Goals at today's meeting.

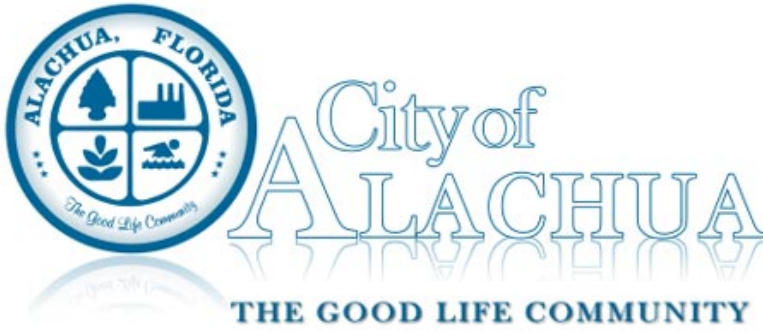

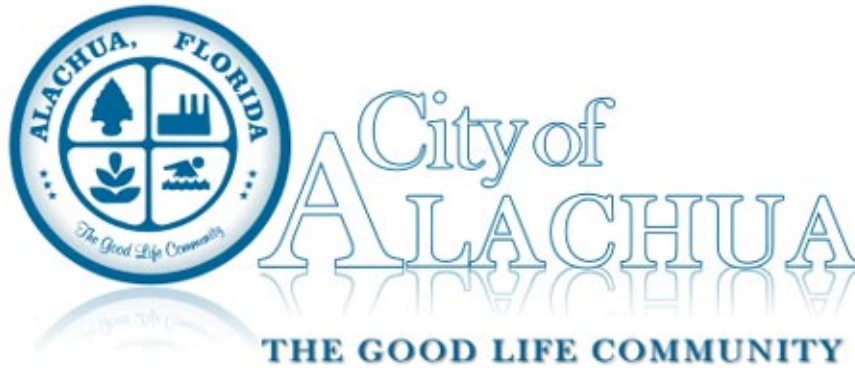
