The locations where we have boxes as drop points are:

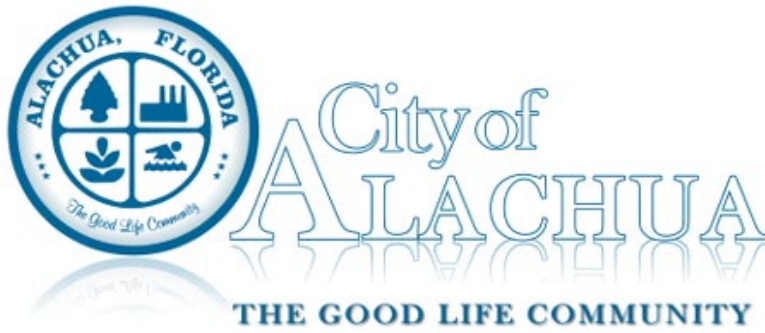

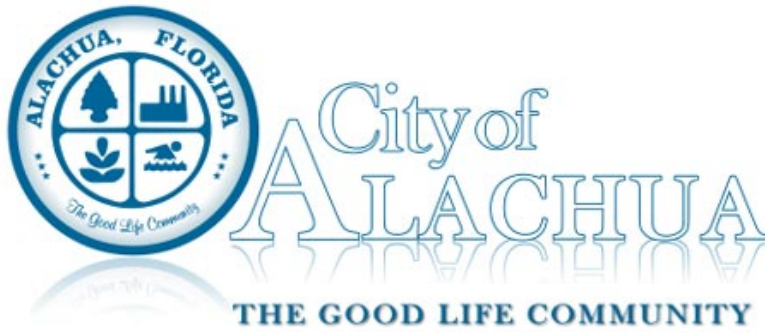

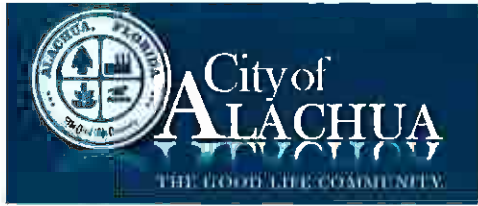
