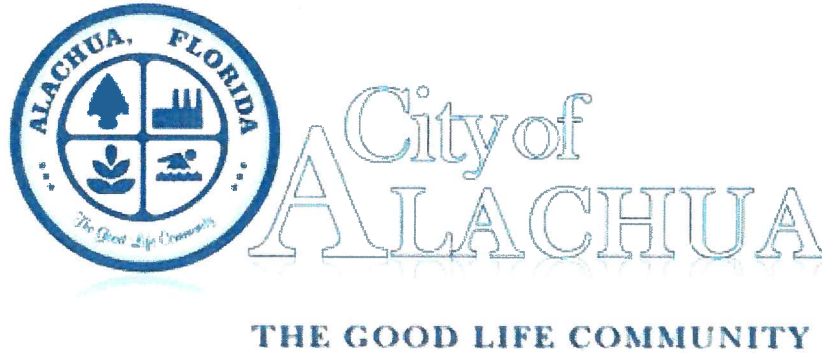

Chair Walls opened the floor for comments.

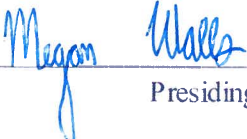

Member Morris moved to adjourn; seconded by Member Addison Grosz.

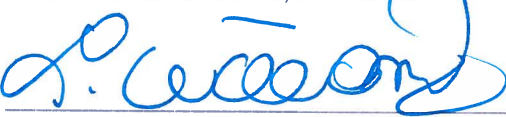
