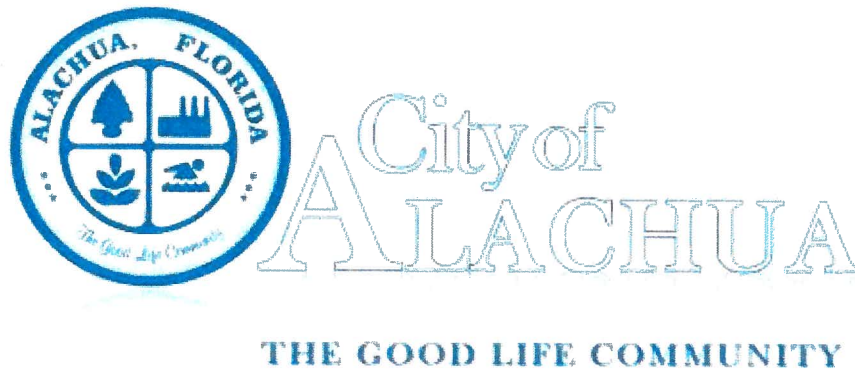

Chair Walls opened the floor for comments.

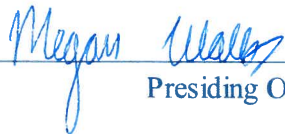

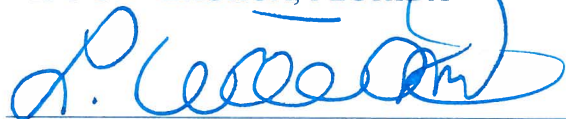
